I have the honour to report that the news of the change of administration at Constantinople, of which Your Excellency was good enough to apprise me in your telegram of the 15th instant, aroused considerable excitement here. Public opinion was unanimous in condemning the overthrow of Helmi Pasha's Cabinet, and this afternoon a meeting was convened,

Several speeches were made and a resolution

resolution was telegraphed to Constantinople
by the Mutessarif.
