My Lord

Jerusalem  
November 5. 1861

I have the honour to report  
that on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Ultime arrived  
in this City. The Count de  
Chambord attended by a  
number of friends who had  
come voluntarily for the pleasure  
of being with him in Palestine

including the Duke de Lewis,  
the Count de Blacas, and the  
Count de Damas.

They had particular attentions  
paid to them by the Austrian  
Consul, who had prepared  
apartments for them in the  
great Austrian Hospice which  
has never yet been inhabited.

But the party preferred to be  
regarded in the light of pilgrims  
for devotion - and took lodgings

in the common place assigned by  
the monks, for pilgrims, denominated  
the Casa nuova, where they were  
considered guests of the Convent

They went to Bethlehem and  
the Jordan, and left us to day  
for Jaffa for embarkation.

Most of the Consuls (of course  
excepting the French) paid private  
visits to the Count de Chambord  
and were pleased with the  
graciousness and affability of  
their reception.
