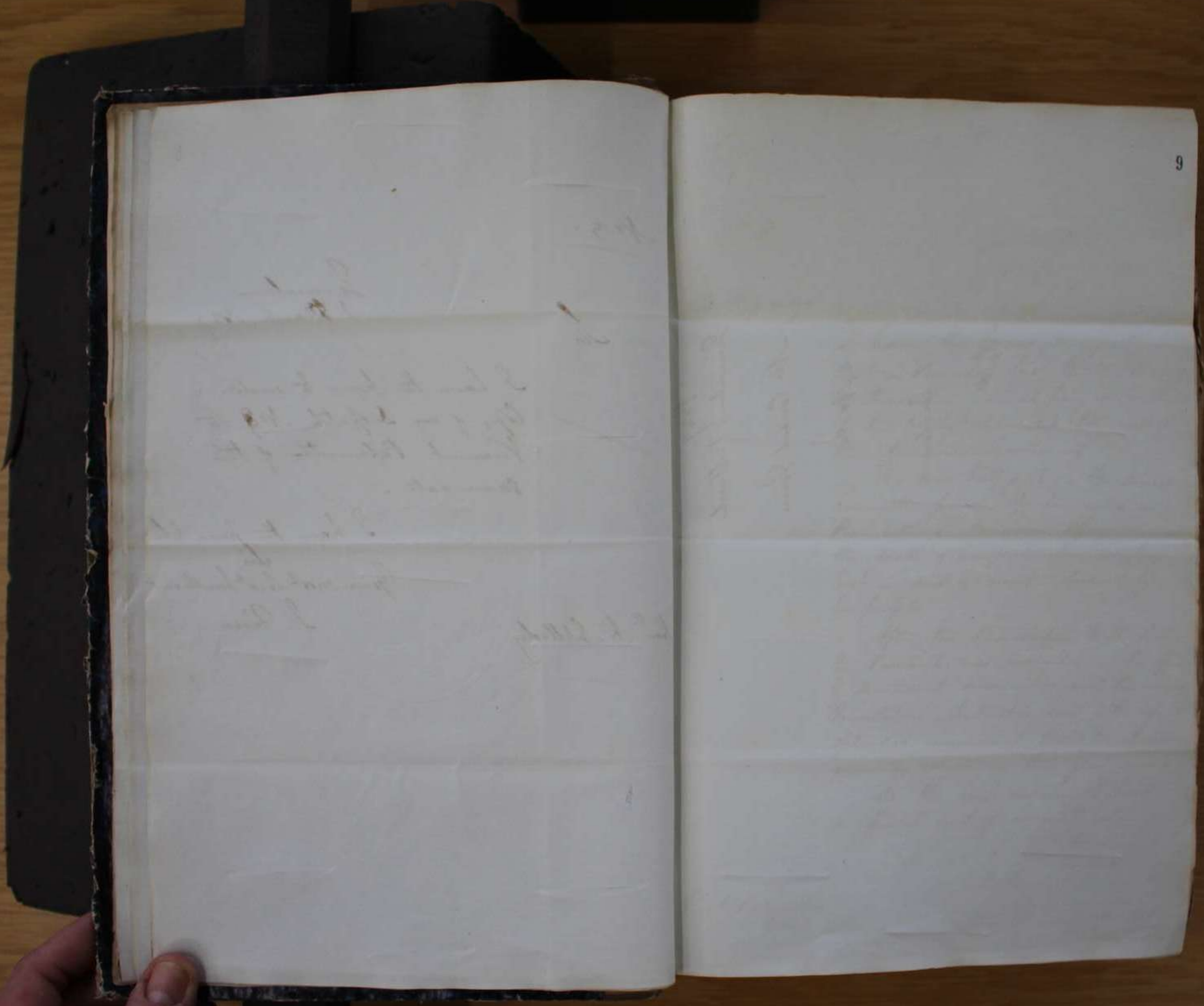

I have the honor to report that on Thursday last the 25 February the Decoration arrived from Constantinople for the newly appointed Patriarch of the Armenian Community

The new Patriarch is the same venerable person who has acted as Procurator of Armenian affairs since the death of his predecessor in May last - and is much esteemed by his people.

After the Presentation to the Pasha the Patriarch was installed in his office by devotional solemnities and the usual Investiture, but it is said with less of splendid ceremonial than the Armenians generally exhibit on their great occasions.
